NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Ashford will conduct a public hearing by the Board of Selectmen on Monday, February 4, 2019, at 6:30 pm in the Ashford Town Hall to discuss the Town's 2016 Community Development Block Grant program and to solicit citizen input. The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain citizen's views on the Town's community development and housing needs and review and discuss the project of the Ashford Food Program. The public hearing will give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known on the program and for approval of the Program Income Reuse Plan.
