 - A. Status of after school childcare program: the BOS discussed the status of the program which included setting a weekly rate (5 days) of \$100 payable on the 15th of the preceding month; institution of an on-line application process to begin 8/2/2023; using a lottery format to choose program participants; department budget being put together by Treasurer; the Social Service Director will work with families experiencing financial hardships; proposed salary rates were discussed (\$25/hr for lead position, \$22/hr for assistant, \$18-\$20 for helper depending on experience; scheduling of staff interviews. The BOS commended the Superintendent and Social Service Director for their work on the project.
 - B. Act on Ashford School Building Committee recommendation regarding issuance of RFP for architectural services relating to the Ashford School roof project: The RFQ will be fine-tuned and put on the CTSource website
